


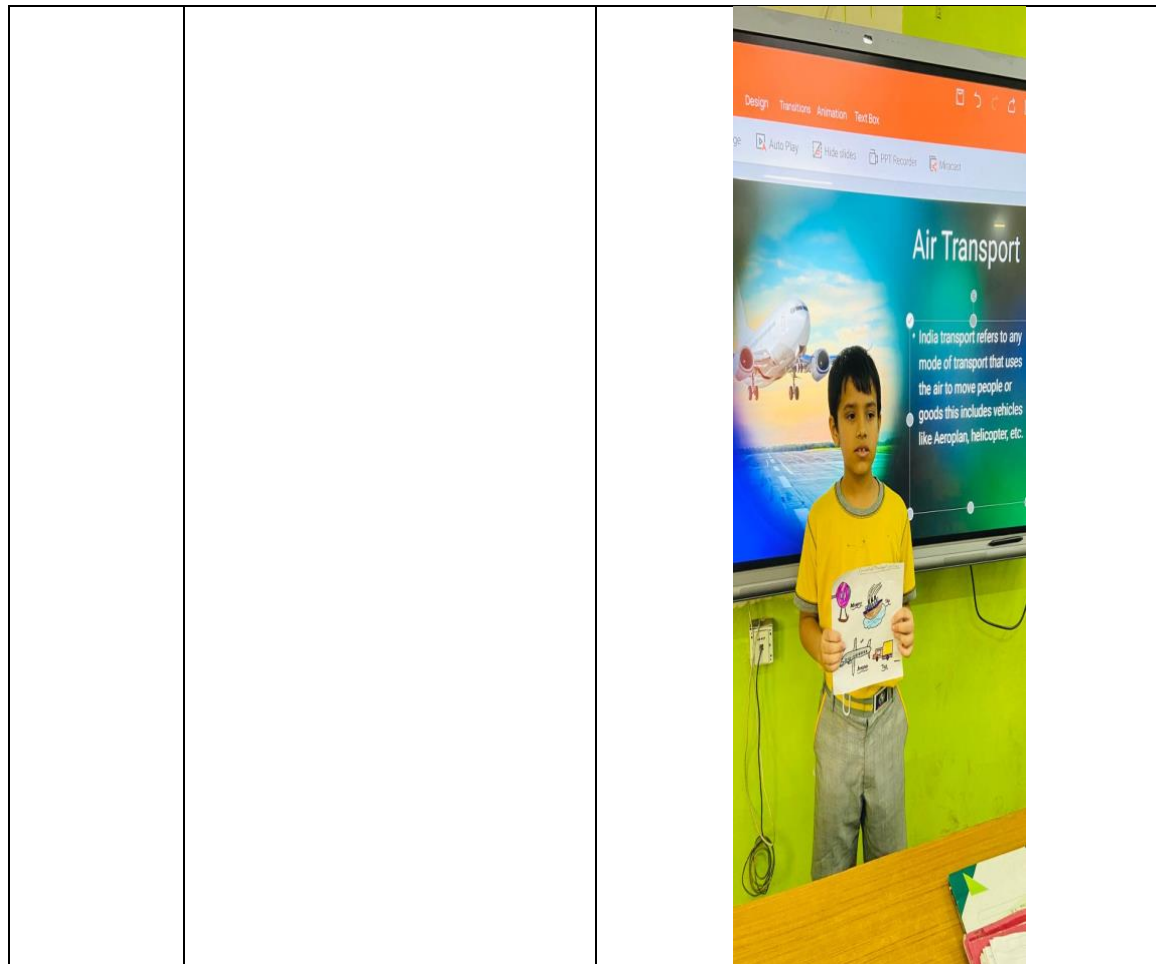


REPORT OF THE ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED IN THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER 2024

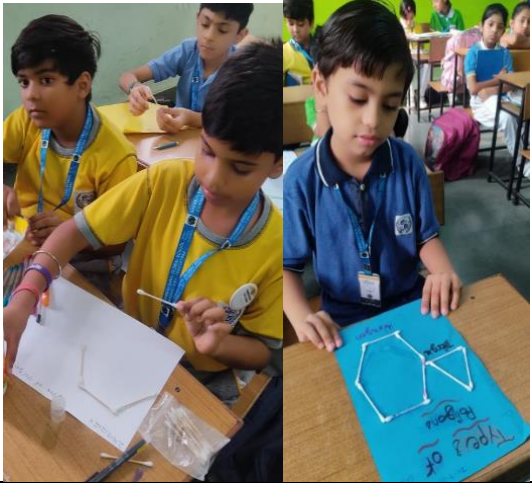
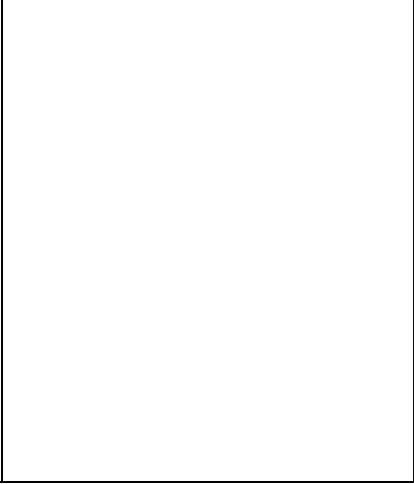
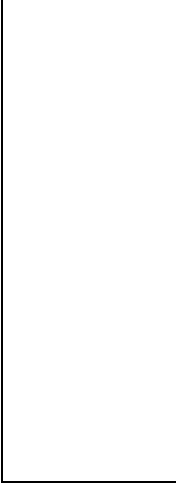
MATHS

In the "Shape Picture Creation" activity, 3rd-grade students use basic geometric shapes like circles, squares, triangles, and rectangles to create a picture, such as a house, animal, or abstract design. After drawing their picture with these shapes, they color it in and share their creations with the class, identifying the shapes they used. This activity helps students practice recognizing and applying geometric shapes in a fun and creative way.

Activity- Make different polygons with matchsticks.
 Create complex shapes by combining smaller polygons.
 Use colored matchsticks to create patterns or designs within the polygons.
 This activity is great for visualizing geometry concepts and enhancing spatial reasoning skills. Enjoy your matchstick creations

Activity- Make different angles with matchsticks.
 A fun activity for students to create different angles with matchsticks! This will help them understand various types of angles (acute, obtuse, right angle, etc.) while improving their hands-on skills.





ENGLISH

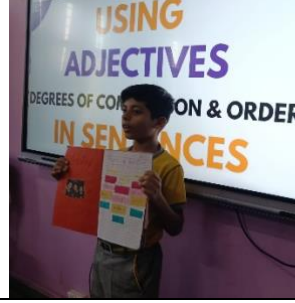
Adjective Hunt is a fun activity for Grade 3 where students search for descriptive words (adjectives) within a story or around their classroom environment. They write down or share the adjectives they find and use them to describe objects, animals, or people. This helps enhance their vocabulary and understanding of how adjectives bring details to writing.



In the **'Article Hunt!'** activity, 4th-grade students practice using articles (***a*, *an*, *the***) by filling in missing articles in sentences. They work individually or in pairs to complete sentences like "___ dog is playing in ___ yard," then review their answers as a class. This activity helps reinforce the correct use of articles and enhances students' understanding of grammar in a fun, interactive way.

Adjective Rela

This activity adds more and competition to reinforce the concept of degrees of comparison, making it educational and fun! Students sit in a group, look at a picture from the newspaper/magazine and paste it in a file. They search the adjectives and share it with their group member as Degrees of comparison.
