ENGLISH	Thumb Impression on Letters The Thumb Impression on Letters activity is a creative and educational exercise for young children that helps develop fine motor skills, enhances letter recognition, and makes learning enjoyable. By combining art with literacy, children engage in a fun and effective way to learn about letters and express their creativity.
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	Letter Craft Engaging in letter craft activities, such as cutting, gluing, and drawing, helps children develop fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination. These skills are crucial for writing and other precise tasks.



"Music Chair Alphabet Song" (Prep)

In the "Music Chair Alphabet Song" game for a prep class, set up a circle of chairs, one fewer than the number of students. Play an alphabet song while students walk around the chairs. When the music stops, they must quickly find a chair to sit in. Instead of just removing a chair each round, incorporate alphabet learning by calling out a letter or showing an alphabet flashcard when the music stops. Students should identify the letter and say a word that starts with that letter before sitting down. This combines physical activity with alphabet recognition and helps reinforce letter-sound associations in a fun, interactive
