

This continues until everyone has had a chance to introduce themselves. The game helps children remember each other's names, encourages social interaction, and builds a sense of community in the classroom.


MATHS

Learning Players land on one foot in single spaces and land in side-by-side spaces with two feet, one foot in each space. These movements offer opportunities to talk about space and place. While playing, children practice the counting sequence and seeing and naming numerals.
