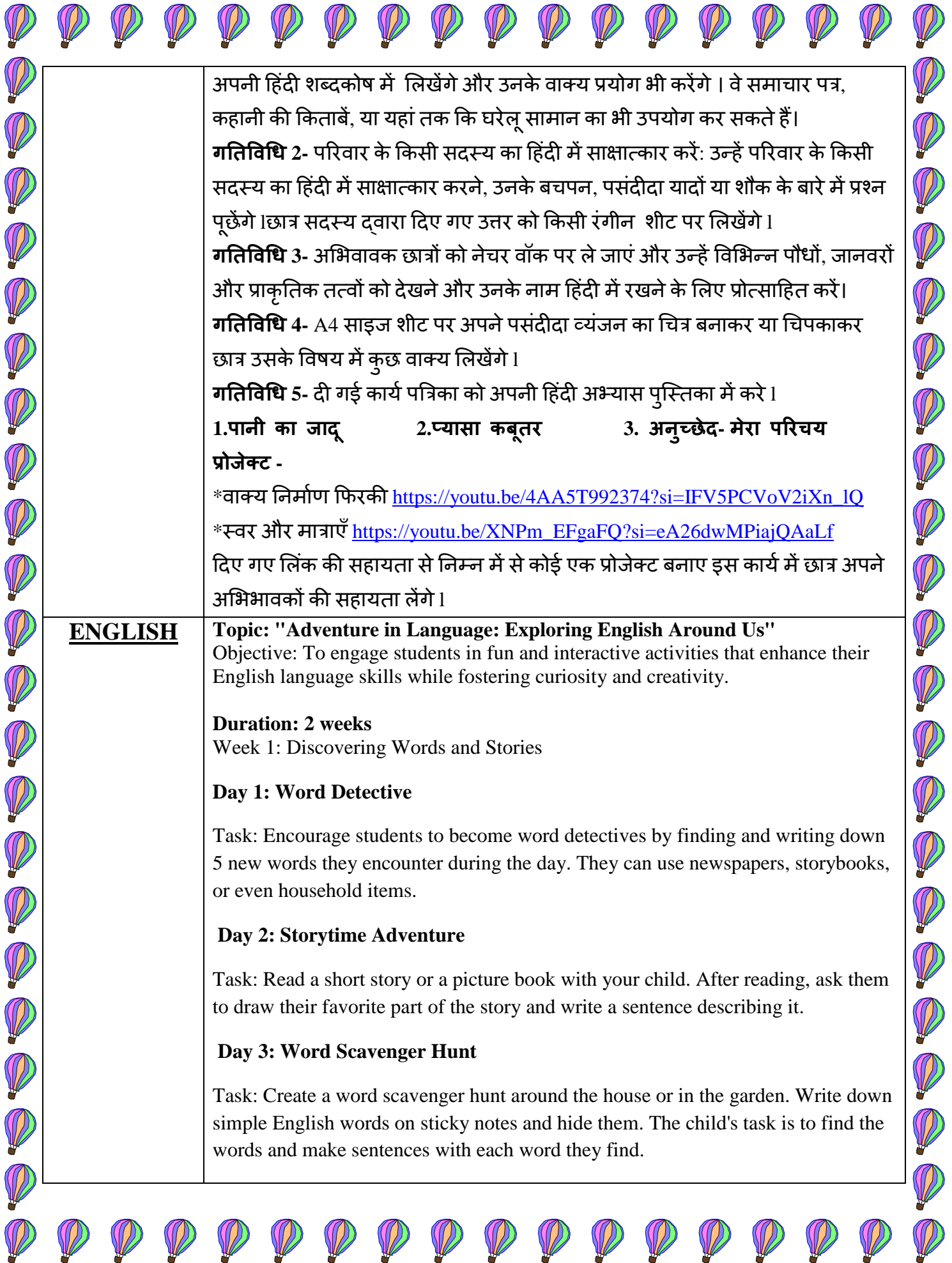

ENGLISH

Topic: "Adventure in Language: Exploring English Around Us"

Objective: To engage students in fun and interactive activities that enhance their English language skills while fostering curiosity and creativity.

Duration: 2 weeks

Week 1: Discovering Words and Stories

Day 1: Word Detective

Task: Encourage students to become word detectives by finding and writing down 5 new words they encounter during the day. They can use newspapers, storybooks, or even household items.

Day 2: Storytime Adventure

Task: Read a short story or a picture book with your child. After reading, ask them to draw their favorite part of the story and write a sentence describing it.

Day 3: Word Scavenger Hunt

Task: Create a word scavenger hunt around the house or in the garden. Write down simple English words on sticky notes and hide them. The child's task is to find the words and make sentences with each word they find.

Day 4: Story Sequencing

Task: Choose a short story and print out pictures representing different parts of the story. Mix the pictures and ask your child to arrange them in the correct sequence. Afterward, they can narrate the story using the pictures as prompts.

Day 5: Vocabulary Parade

Task: Have a vocabulary parade where each family member dresses up as a word they've learned during the week. Encourage the child to explain the meaning of their chosen word to the family.

Week 2: Creative Expression Through Language

Day 6: Rhyme Time

Task: Introduce your child to simple rhyming words. Have them create a list of rhyming words and then challenge them to write a short poem using those words.

Day 7: Letter Writing Task: Help your child write a letter to a family member or a friend. Guide them through the process of writing a greeting, body, and closing. Encourage them to express themselves freely.

Day 8: DIY Storybook

Task: Provide your child with paper, markers, and stickers. Ask them to create their own storybook with illustrations and simple sentences. They can write about anything they like – a day at the beach, a magical adventure, or a funny encounter.



Feedback and Assessment:

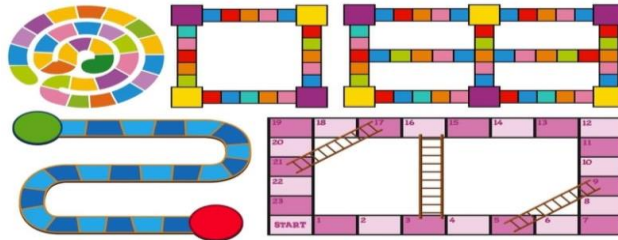

MATHS

Topic: Addition and Subtraction

1. Create your own Math Board Game - For this math project, Students are tasked with creating their own math-related board game based on addition/subtraction one of their choices. To complete this, you must choose a concept, plan your game, create a game board, design game pieces, use spinners or dice to determine how players will navigate the board, test and revise the game and present the final product to the class.



Math Project Ideas: Create Your Own Math Board Game!

Math challenge: Student must complete this challenge of addition and subtraction. Here are some pictures whose number is given in the hint. You need to calculate by identifying the correct numbers of the given pictures. So, let's get started.....

A: (Hint- start with the blue cars!)

Blue Car = 9

Scooter = 7

Helicopter = 8

Jet = 4

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Blue Car} - 2 &= \text{Scooter} \\ \text{Blue Car} + \text{Blue Car} + \text{Blue Car} &= 27 \\ \text{Scooter} &= \text{Helicopter} - 1 \\ \text{Helicopter} &= \text{Jet} + \text{Jet} \\ \text{Jet} &= ? \end{aligned}$$

B: (Hint- 8 minus what number is that same number?)

T.V = 4

Camera = 8

iPhone = 4

Microscope = 6

? = 6

$$\begin{aligned} \text{Camera} &= \text{iPhone} + \text{iPhone} \\ 8 - \text{T.V} &= \text{T.V} \\ \text{Microscope} &= 2 + \text{iPhone} \\ \text{iPhone} &= \text{T.V} \\ \text{Camera} + \text{T.V} - \text{Microscope} &= ? \end{aligned}$$
