
















<p><u>Topic- Weather Wonders</u> Activity - Weather Adventure Story</p> <p><u>Objective:</u> Students will write a fun **weather adventure story** and create an illustration to express their creativity.</p> <p><u>Materials Required:</u>  Scrapfile SA2  Pencil/Pen  Word bank with weather words (optional)  Crayons or colors (for drawing)</p> <p><u>Step-by-Step Procedure:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Think About an Exciting Weather Adventure (5 minutes)**  Imagine a fun weather story! Choose one: - **A magical umbrella that talks**  - **A rainbow leading to a hidden treasure**  - **A sunny day turning into a surprise rainstorm**  Ask yourself: - Who is in my story? - Where does it happen? - What exciting thing happens? 2. Write a Short Story (15 minutes)  Write a **6–8 sentence story** about your weather adventure.  Example story: *"One day, I found a magical umbrella. It could fly! It took me above the clouds, where I met a rainbow bird. Together, we soared across the sky. The bird told me about a secret treasure hidden at the end of the rainbow. I followed the bright colors and found a golden chest full of sparkling stars!"*  Use **weather words** like:  Sunshine  Rain  Umbrella  Rainbow  Clouds  Wind 3. Read Your Story Aloud (10 minutes)  Read your story to your family or friends!  Talk about the **weather words** you used. 4. Draw a Picture (10 minutes)  Draw a **beautiful illustration** to match your adventure story!  Show your magical umbrella, rainbow treasure, or rainy surprise. 	<p><u>Topic: Weather Wonder</u></p> <p>Task 1: Weather Survey and Bar Graph</p> <p>Observe the weather for 10 days and record it in a table (sunny, cloudy, rainy, windy, etc.).</p> <p>Tally each type of weather.</p> <p>Draw a bar graph to show how many days had each type of weather.</p> <p>Write 2 sentences about your findings (e.g., “Sunny days were the most common”).</p> <p>Task 2: Temperature Tracking and Comparison</p> <p>Note the temperature at morning and afternoon for 5 days (use a thermometer or ask an adult).</p> <p>Use subtraction to find the difference between morning and afternoon temperatures.</p> <p>Write which day had the biggest difference and what kind of weather it was.</p> <p>Note:- Do all the above in Scrapbook 2.</p>

1.Aquaculture Activity

Activity Title:

“Make Cocopeat and Plant a Seed!”

Materials Needed:

- A small piece of **dry coconut husk** or store-bought cocopeat block
- A **bowl of water**
- A **plastic cup or pot** with small holes at the bottom
- A spoon or small scoop
- Seeds (e.g., mustard, fenugreek, coriander, or green gram)

Instructions:

1. Soak the Cocopeat

- Place the coconut husk or cocopeat block in a bowl of water.
- Let it soak for a few minutes until it becomes **soft and fluffy**.
- Show the child how it **expands like a sponge!**

2. Fill the Cup

- Help the child scoop the fluffy cocopeat into a plastic cup or small pot.

3. Plant the Seeds

- Sprinkle the seeds on top of the cocopeat.
- Gently press them down with your fingers (do not bury deep!).

4. Water and Observe

- Sprinkle a little water every day.
- Place the cup near sunlight.
- Watch the seeds sprout in 2–3 days.
