<p><b>Nature Walk and Picture Collage</b></p> <p><b>Task:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Go on a short walk with your child.</li> <li>Pick up or take photos of <b>green leaves, flowers, clean places, or trash if you see any.</b></li> <li>Make a <b>collage</b> of “Things That Make the Earth Happy” and “Things That Hurt the Earth.”</li> </ul> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p><b>Coloring Activity</b></p> <p><b>Worksheet:</b> Draw or print a picture of the Earth (happy Earth and sad Earth).</p> <p><b>Task:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Color (blue and green) the <b>happy Earth</b> that is surrounded by trees, clean water, sunshine, and animals.</li> <li>Color (black) the <b>sad Earth</b> that has smoke, garbage, and no trees.</li> <li>Talk to your child about what makes the Earth happy or sad.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Activity: Count the Trees</b></p> <p><b>Instructions:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Provide tree stickers or pictures.</li> <li>Ask the child to count and write numbers 1 to 10.</li> </ul> <p><b>Scrapbook Task:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Paste 10 tree pictures.</li> <li>Write numbers 1 to 10 below each one.</li> </ul> <p><b>Number Practice (1–50)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Write numbers 1 to 50</li> <li>Count and color objects: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> Draw 5 apples and color them.</li> <li> Draw 3 cars and color them.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

Draw your favorite part of the story on a sheet of paper.</li> <li> <b>Green Hands – Plant a Sapling</b> With your parents' help, plant a small plant in a pot or garden.  Click a picture of yourself watering the plant and stick it in your notebook. <b>SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT</b> Activity 1: Picture Sorting – Trash or Treasure? Objective: Learn the difference between waste and reusable items. Instructions: Take 10-15 cutouts pictures (or drawings) of items like: Banana peel, plastic bottle, toy, crayon, paper scrap, apple core. Ask the child to paste them into two columns:  Trash (Throw Away)  Treasure (Can Be Reused or Recycled) Do This Activity on A3 size sheet. Activity2- Learn a short rhyme on Solid waste management(Eg- Bins, 5 Rs, etc) like:  Pick up the trash, don’t let it stay, Put it in the bin, that’s the way! Keep your school and home so neat, Make the Earth smell fresh and sweet! <b>GYMNASTICS:</b> <b><u>Stretch &amp; Balance</u></b> Warm-up: 10 Jumping Jacks Arm circles (10 each direction) March in place (1 min) <b>Activities:</b> Balance on one foot (10 sec each leg) Tree pose (like a flamingo – hold for 10 sec) Butterfly stretch (15 sec) Creative Task: Draw yourself doing your favourite gym pose!	KG 2: EMBROIDERY: Activity: Cut a printed blue pottery design into puzzle pieces. Students put the pieces back together to complete the artwork.  POTTERY: Skill focus: Problem-solving, spatial thinking. Activity: Give kids puzzle pieces of a blue pottery item (with a pattern). Let them assemble the design correctly.
